WORK EXPERIENCE:

1986-1996:

Worked as an editorial cartoonist and graphic artist for The Brownsville Herald, a newspaper in South Texas, along the Texas-Mexican border. Created a daily political cartoon as well as designed pages, maps, charts, illustrations and advertisements.

1996-present:

Working as primarily a page designer for the Las Vegas Review-Journal, the largest newspaper in the state of Nevada. I design news, business and feature pages, but the job also requires the creation of charts and graphs and illustrations. The job tasks include conceptualizing the best method to illustrate a story and then seeing that the process to completion, either with a photo, photo illustration, computer aided illustration, hand drawn illustrations, or through a combination of media. Sometimes I will create the artwork for the story or it will be assigned to another artist, depending on the story or time restrictions. The nature of newspapers often requires a quick analysis and a quick turn around of the final product.
